 - one death is a tragedy, two are suspicious and three are murder 1996


One death is a tragedy one million is a statistic Joseph Stalin


Indicators for Sustainable Development **ENVIRONMENT** (Built and natural environments, un-used land, spatial re-structuring, etc.) Socio-**ECONOMY** (Population densities, basic services - water, (Growth, employment, electricity demand, industries, capital education, health, safety, investments, etc.) recreational, Government services, poverty etc.) **Human settlements**


- Requires measuring 'bottom-up' within the place/ neighbourhood/ community/ wards
- Requires strong institutions (local municipalities, districts, cities & provinces)

The 2011 settlement patterns illustrate that policy intentions and public action are at variance with densification on the margins











Mapping the poverty headcount by municipality – 2001-2011




Poverty headcount by municipality – 2001-2011 (SAMPI)






Poverty headcount by municipality – 2001-2011 (SAMPI)



Poverty can be spatially represented and thereby allowing better targeting




Percentage of workers in each age group who are skilled (managers, professionals, technicians)




Percentage of households that have no toilet facility or were using a bucket toilet per province






Estimated percentage of households vulnerable to hunger in South Africa vs Percentage of Households who have benefited from Social grants




Lorenz curves and Gini Coefficient.
