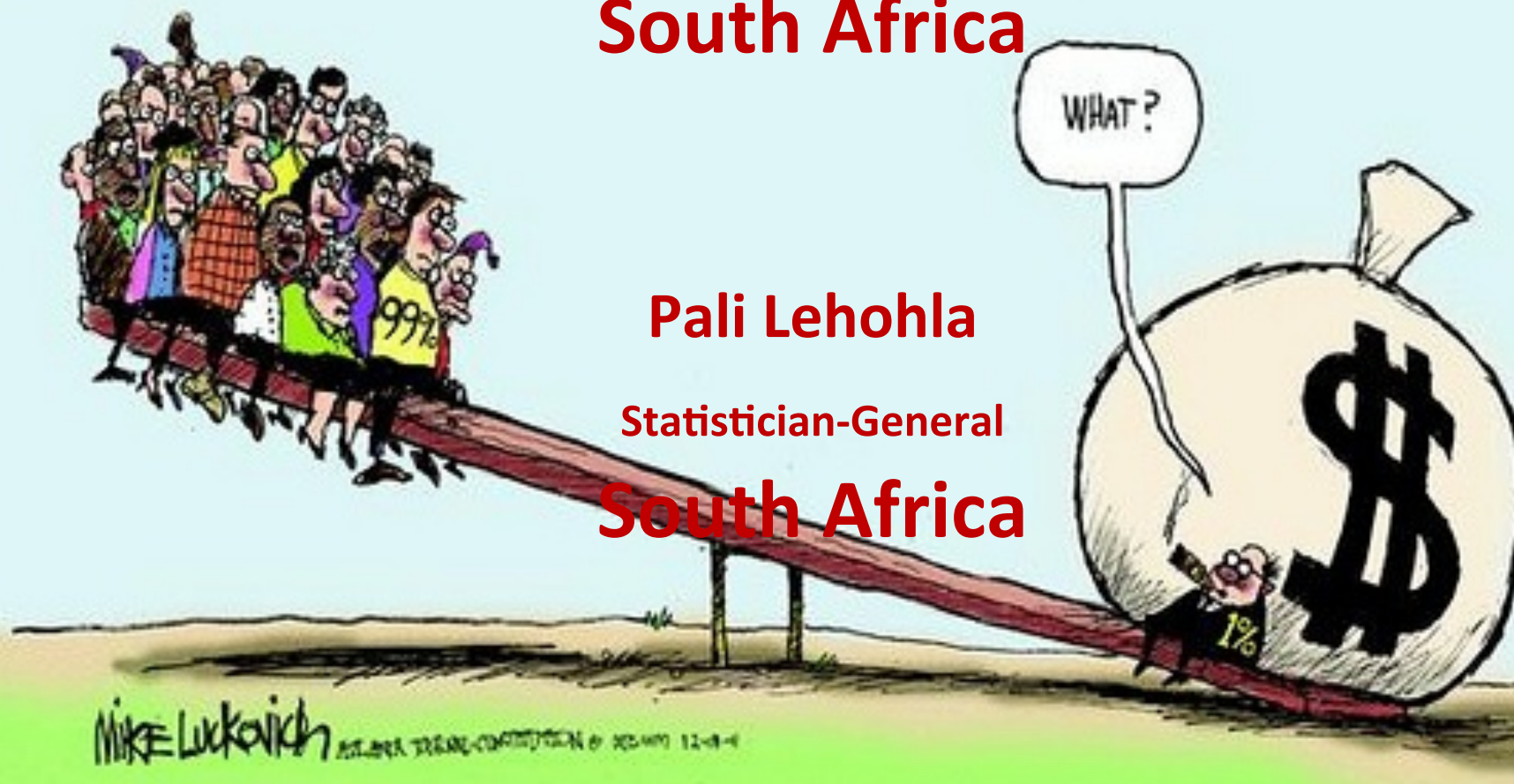

**One death is a tragedy one million is a statistic Joseph Stalin**

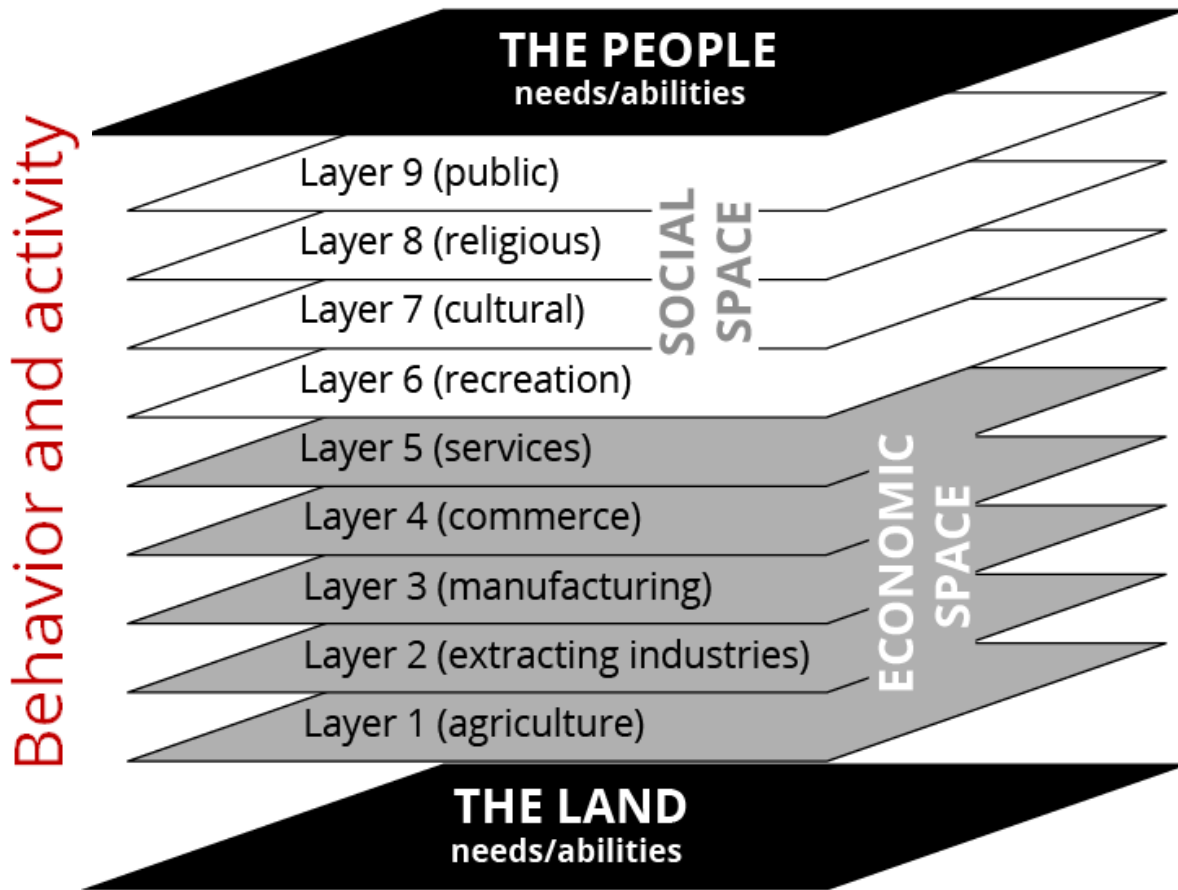
- **David and Kathleen Long and the lotto**

**The Hospital deaths and the Phillipino Nurse**

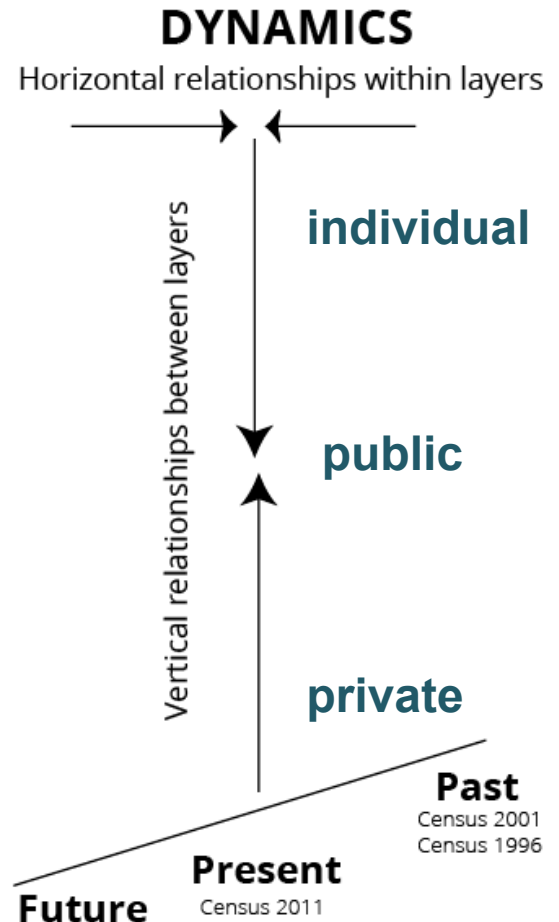
- **Sentenced for three but eleven more apparent 2015**

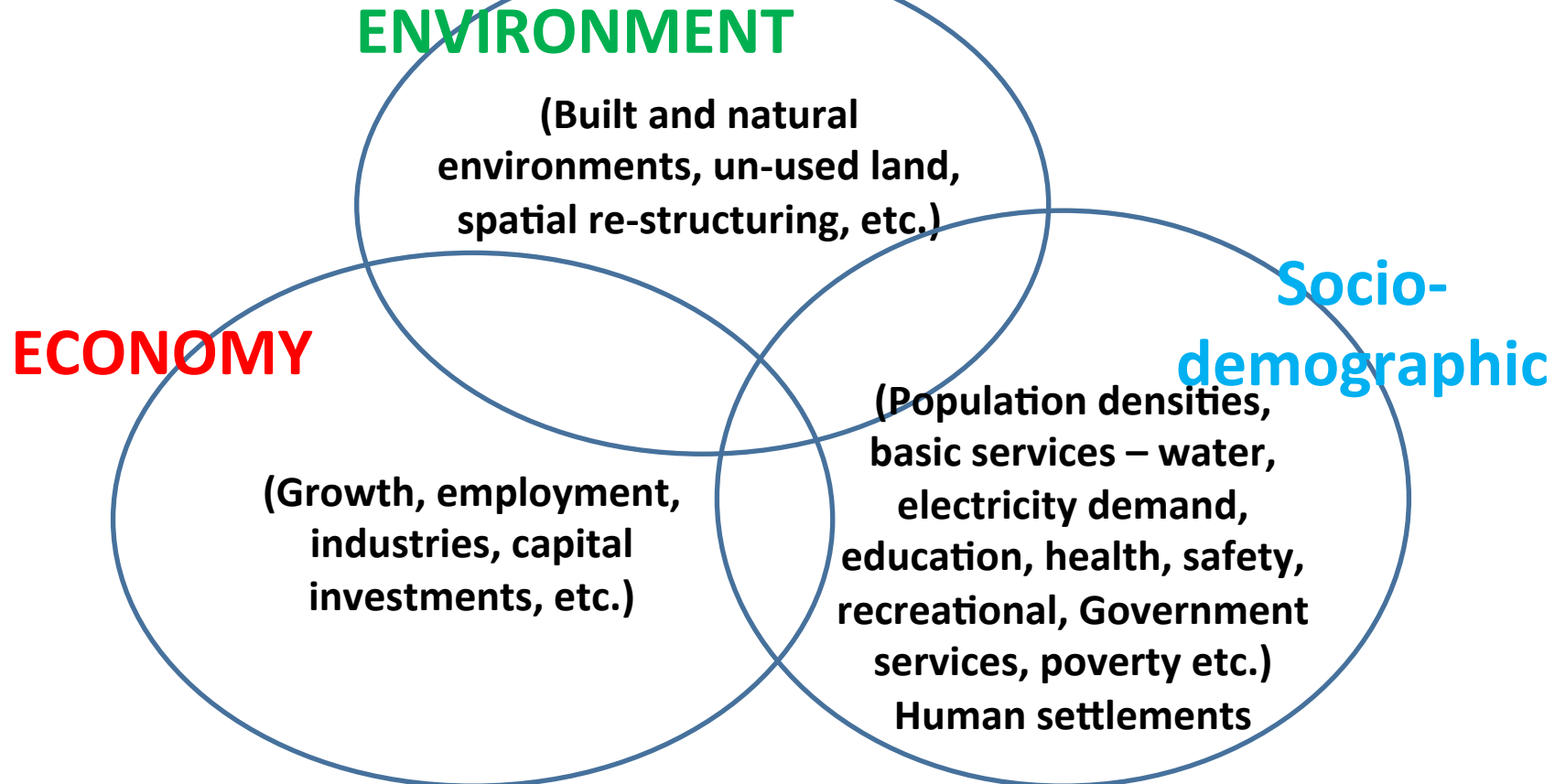

# Indicators for Sustainable Development

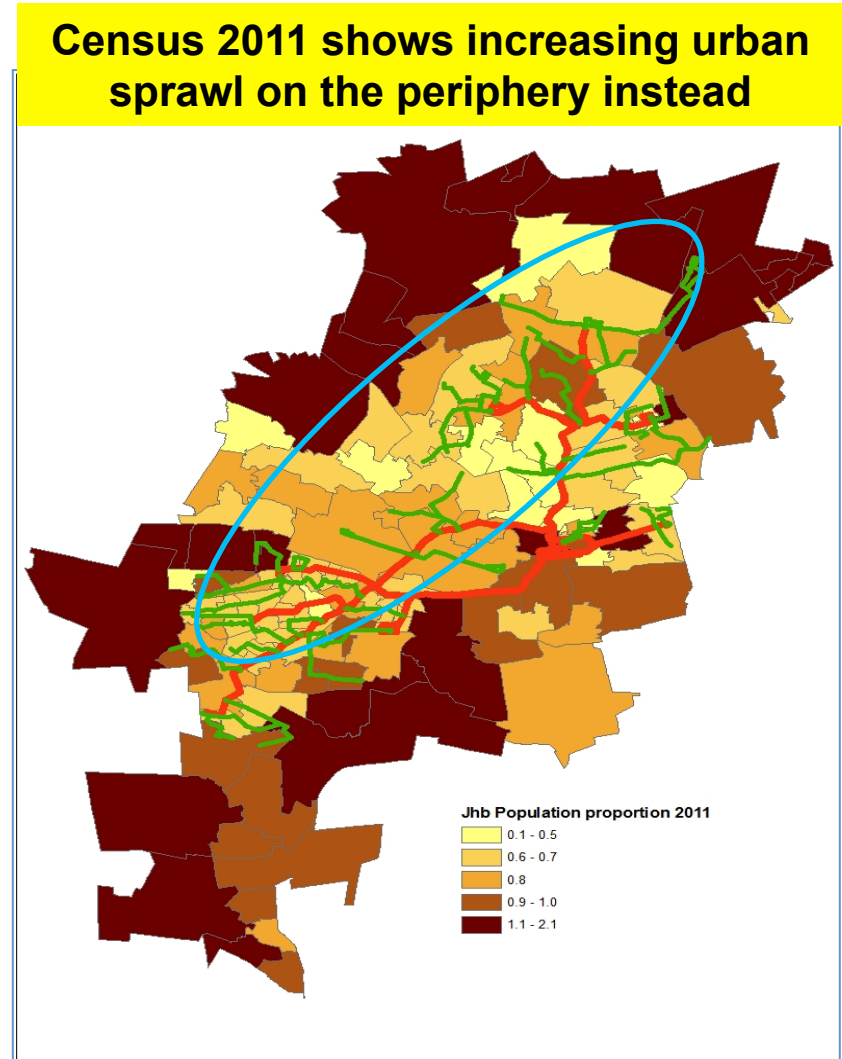
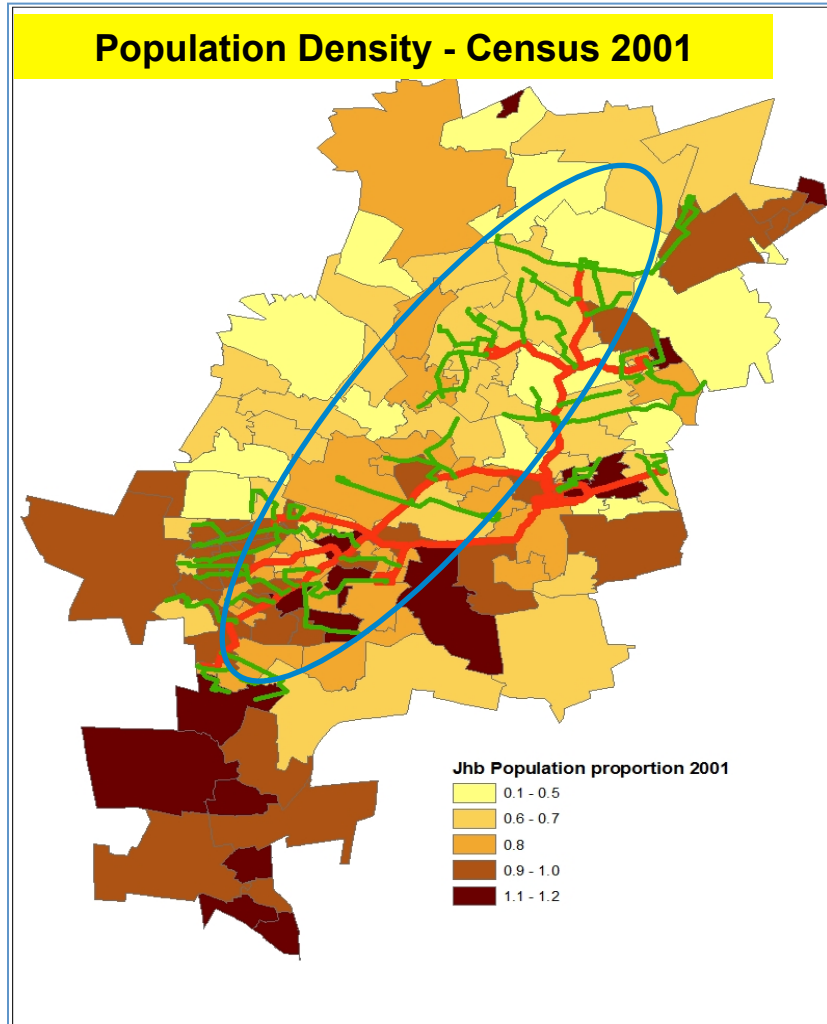
Intersection of natural capital Economy and Society

# Geography as a dimension: Human Settlements policy

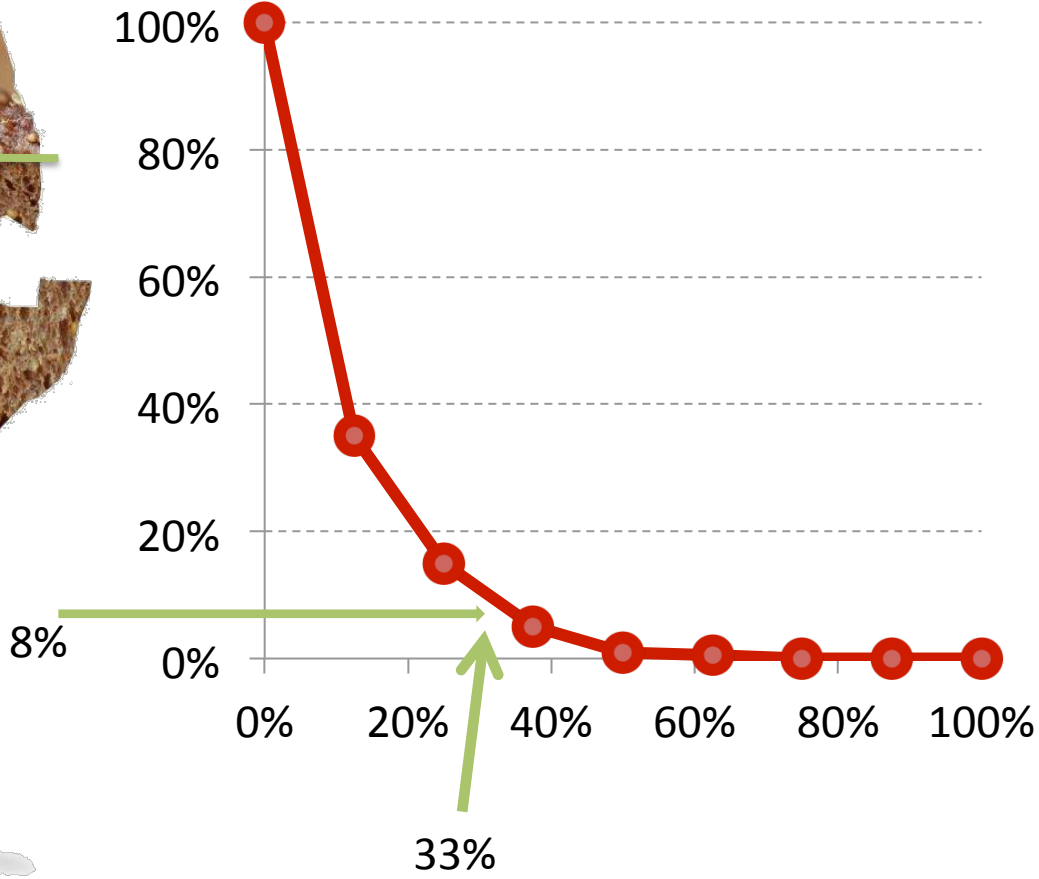
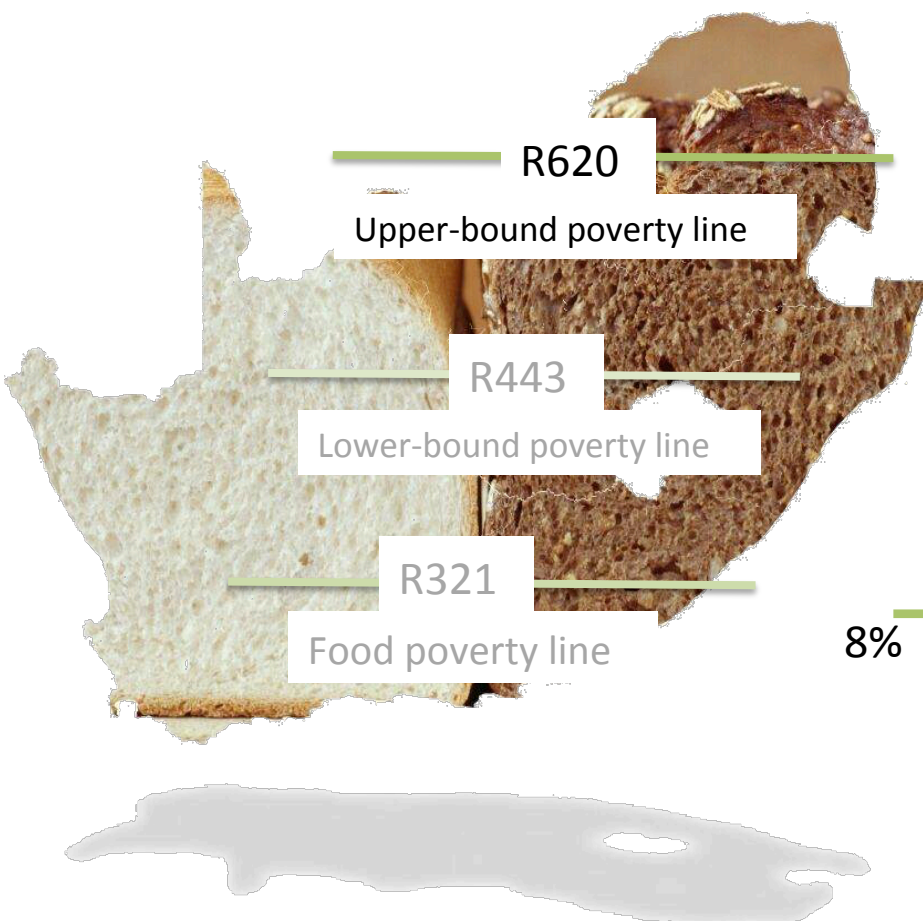
The 2011 settlement patterns illustrate that policy intentions and public action are at variance with densification on the margins

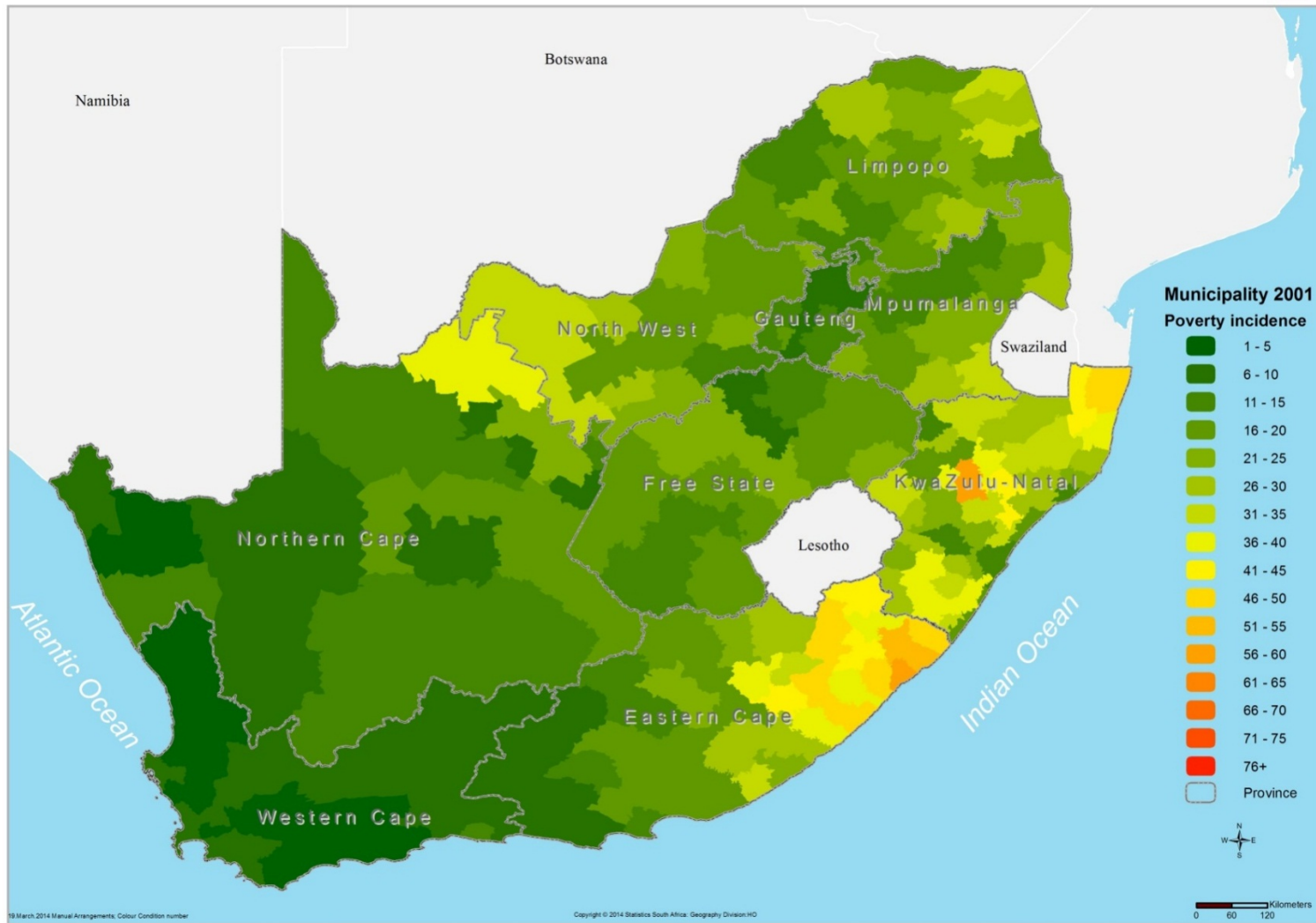

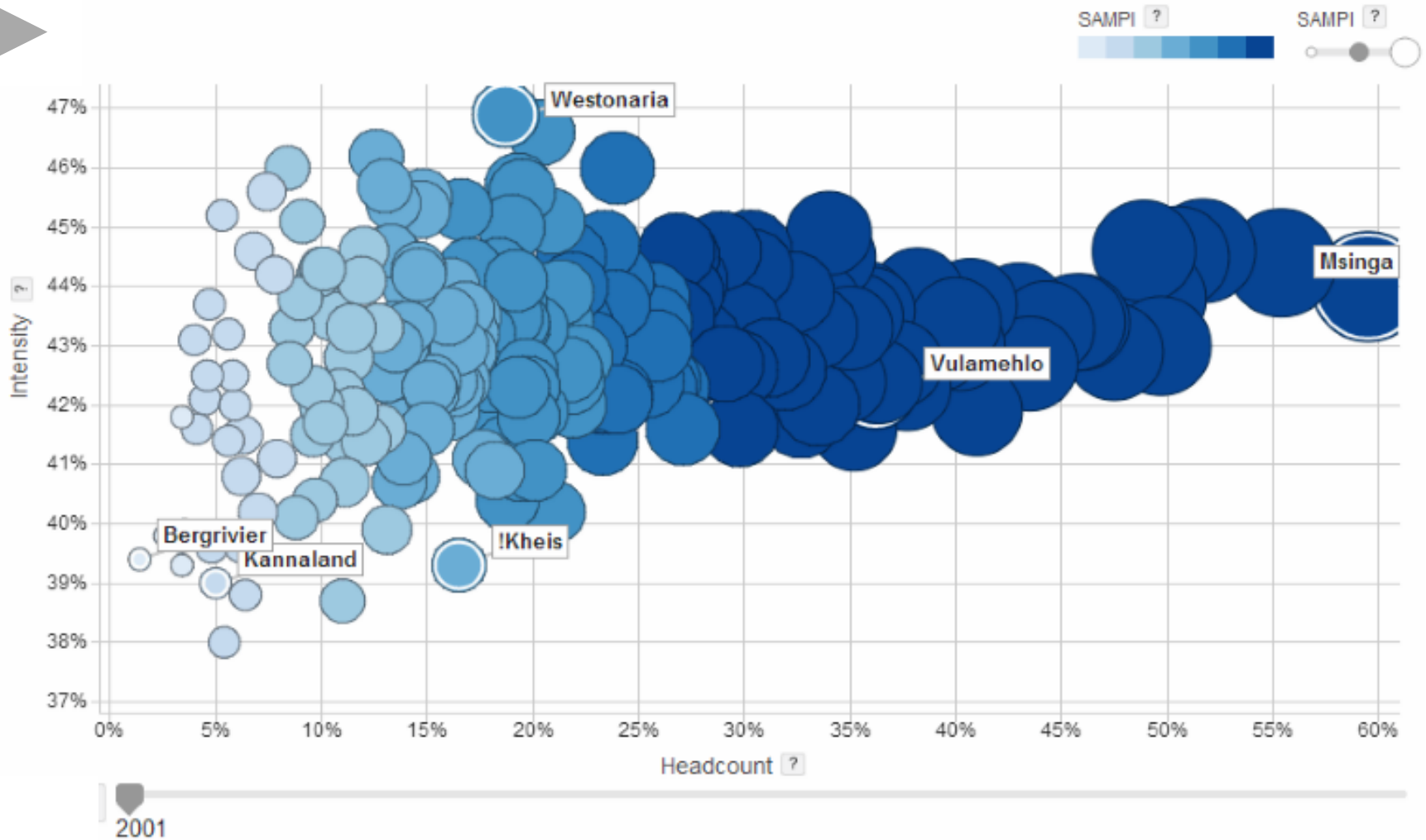




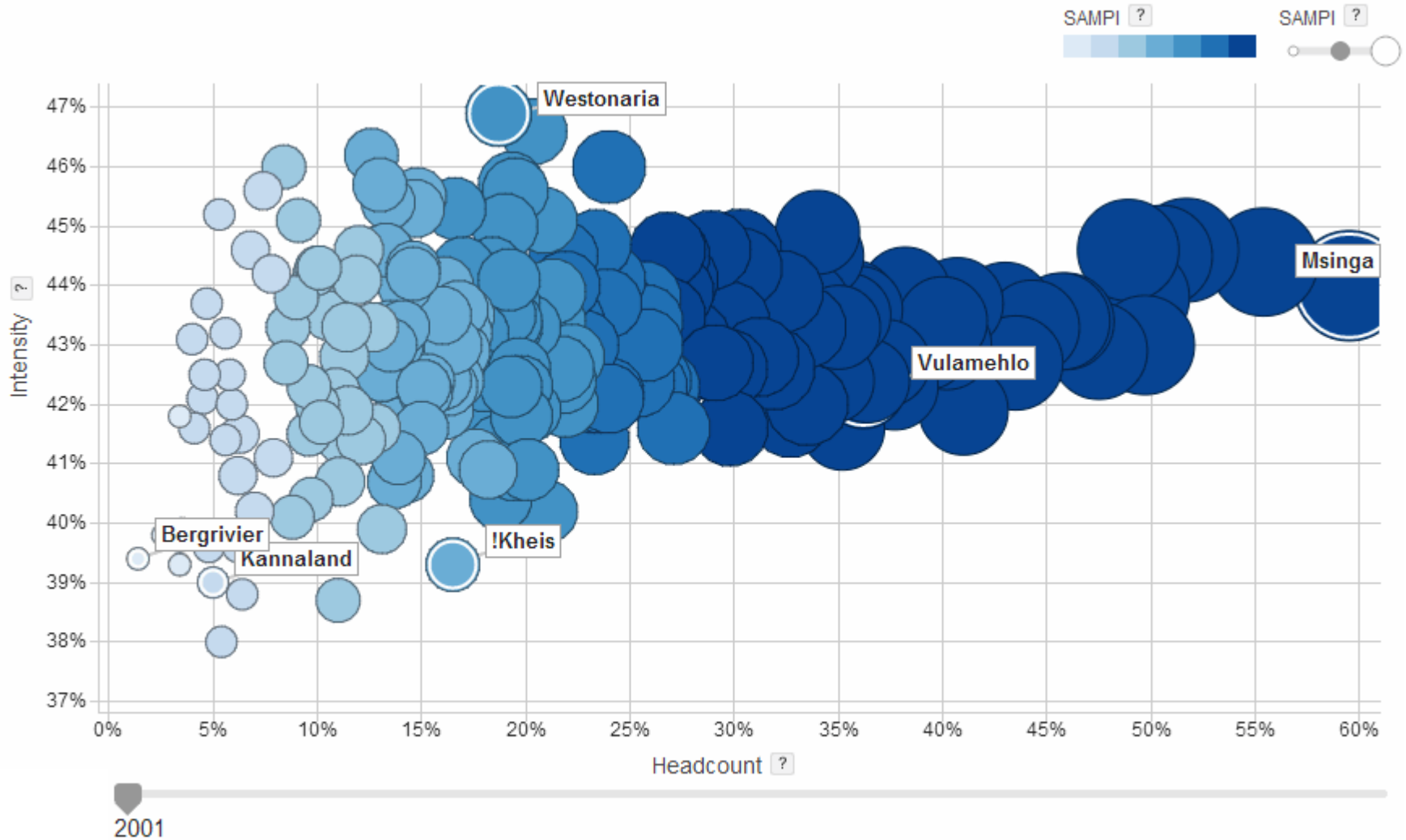
# Mapping the poverty headcount by municipality – 2001-2011



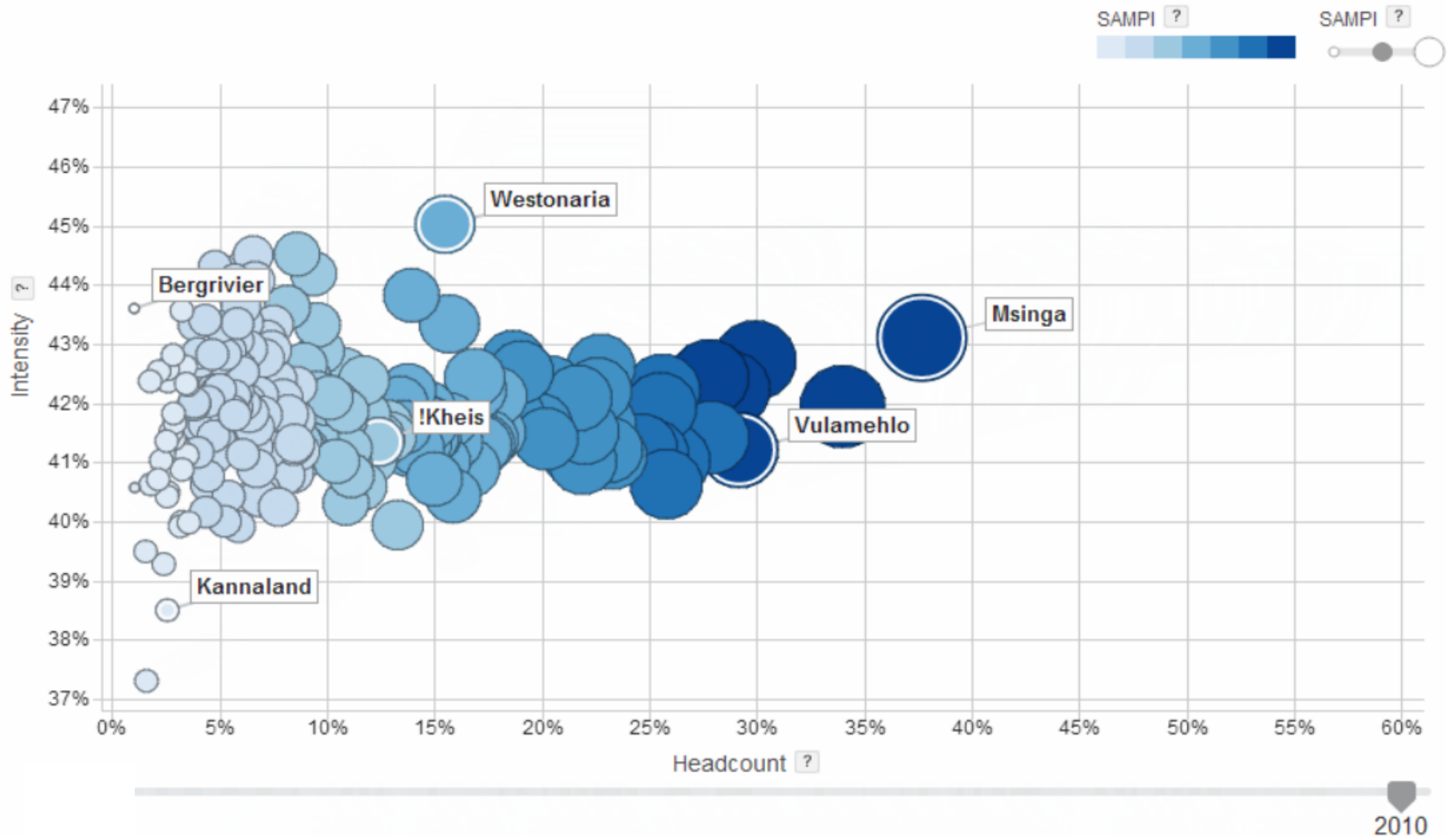
# Poverty headcount by municipality – 2001-2011 (SAMPI)

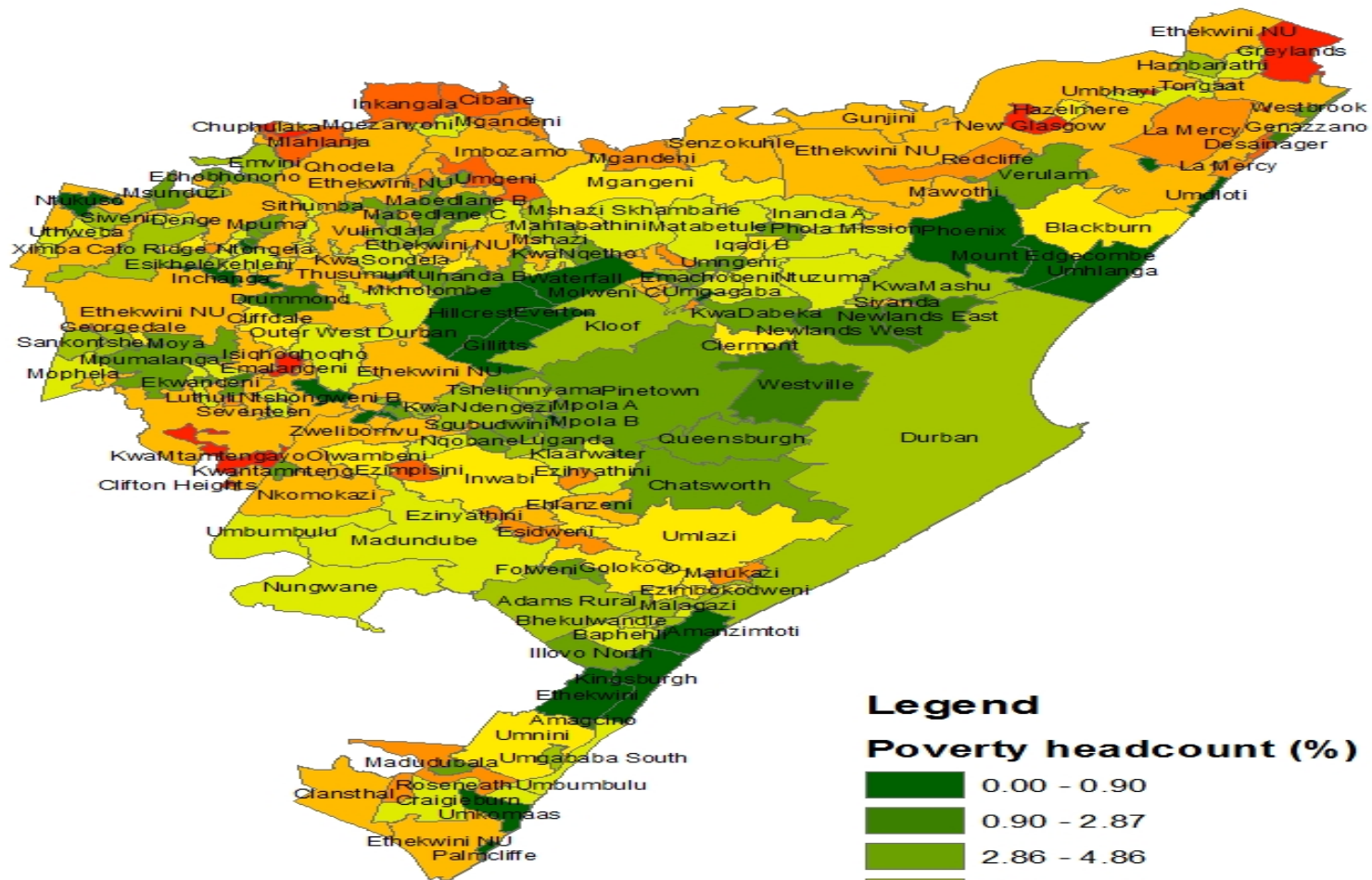

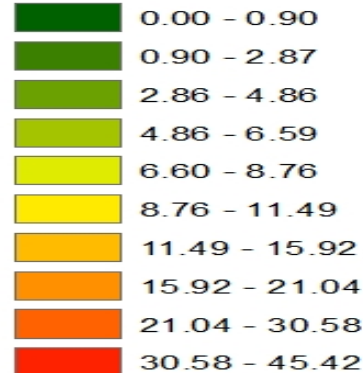

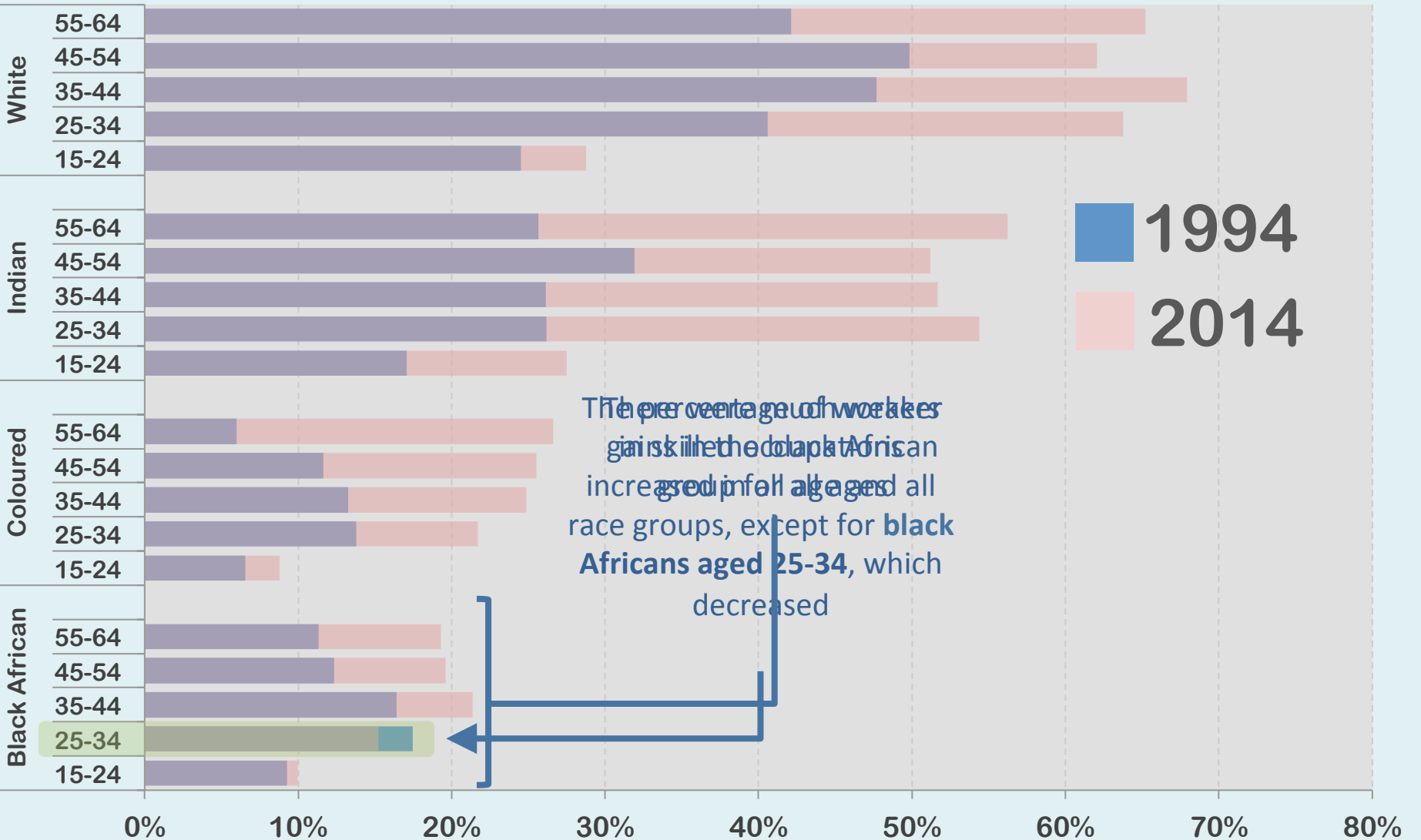

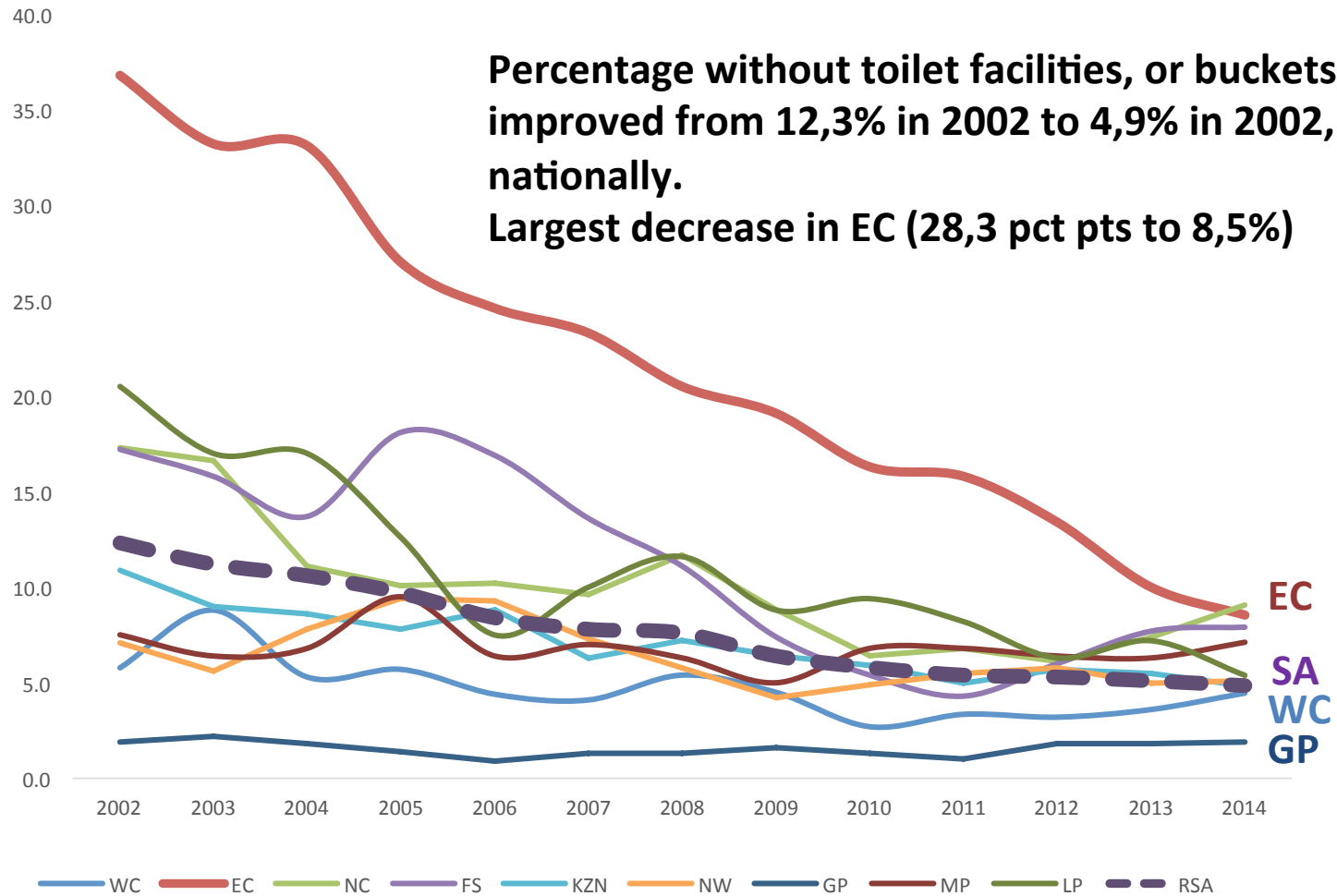

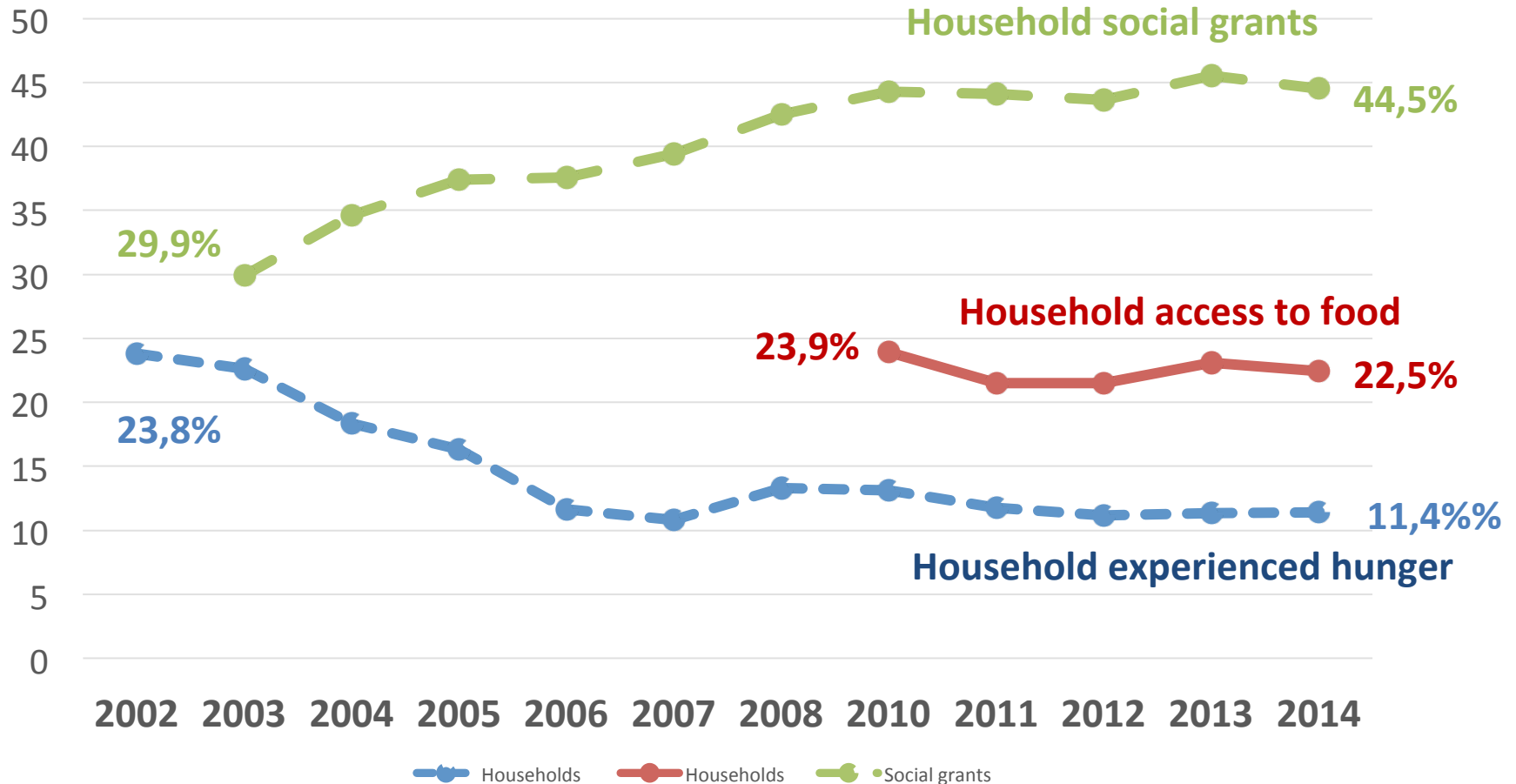
# Percentage of workers in each age group who are skilled (managers, professionals, technicians)



# Percentage of households that have no toilet facility or were using a bucket toilet per province

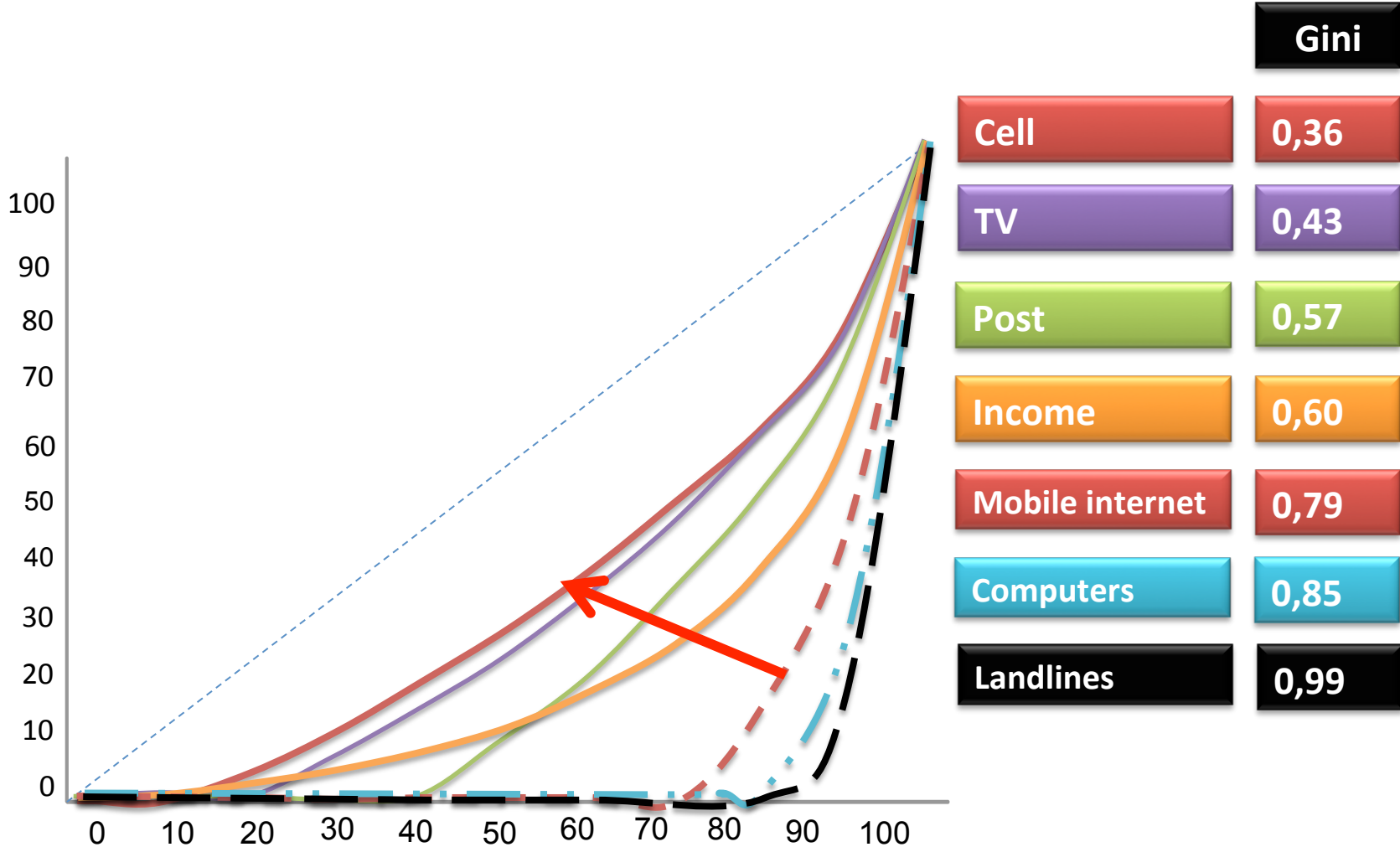


# Estimated percentage of households vulnerable to hunger in South Africa vs Percentage of Households who have benefited from Social grants



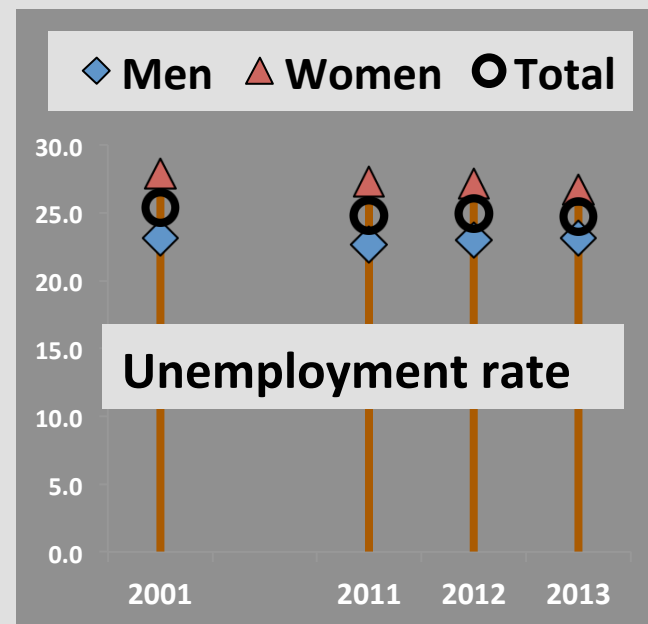
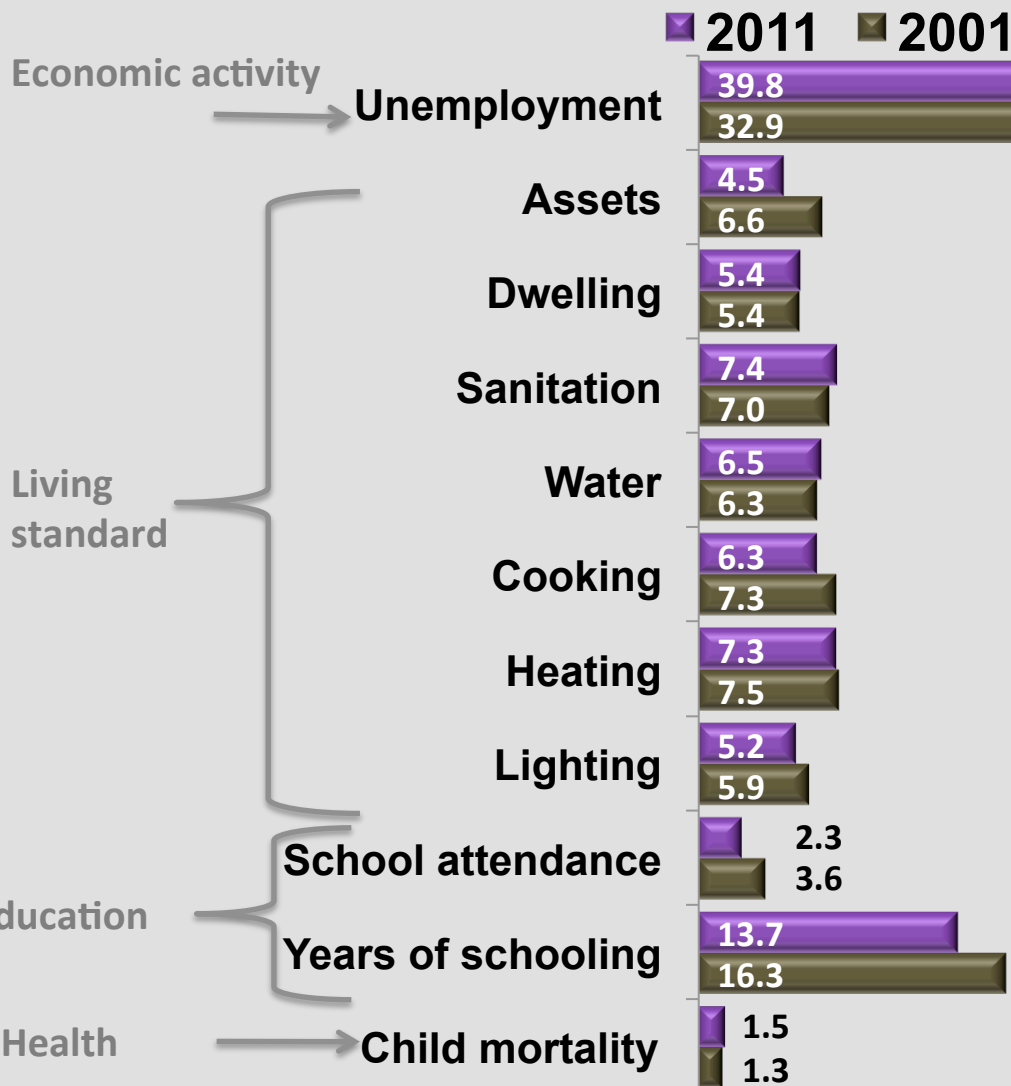


# Lorenz curves and Gini Coefficient.
